(CRC-1) Spare Gennaker

Proposed Rule Change

C.10.2 LIMITATIONS

- (a) Not more than 1 mainsail, 1 headsail and 1 gennaker shall be carried aboard.
- (b) Not more than 1 mainsail, 1 headsail and 1 gennaker shall be presented for **event** measurement and used during an event of 6 or less consecutive days except when a **sail** has been lost or damaged beyond repair.
- (c) One spare class gennaker (that meets the requirements of C.10, G.2 and G.5) may be presented for measurement and registration for an event, and carried aboard, but shall not be used during an event except when the primary gennaker has been lost or damaged to the point where it cannot be effectively repaired while afloat.

Delete I.1 SPARE GENNAKER

Current Rules

C.10.2 LIMITATIONS

- (a) Not more than 1 mainsail, 1 headsail, and 1 gennaker shall be carried aboard.
- (b) Not more than 1 mainsail, 1 headsail, and 1 gennaker shall be presented for **event** measurement and used during an event of 6 or less consecutive days except when a **sail** has been lost or damaged beyond repair.

Section I

I.1 SPARE GENNAKER

One spare class gennaker (that meets the requirements of C.10, G.2 and G.5) may be presented for measurement and registration for an event, and carried aboard, but shall not be used during an event except when the primary gennaker has been lost or damaged to the point where it cannot be effectively repaired while afloat.

Reason for Change

The original restriction was put in place as a cost savings for new owners. After three years, there is a good supply of used sails that can be used as the back-up gennaker.
