

What is Mixed-Plus?

The International J/70 Class Association has added Mixed-Plus divisions and events to the Class Rules. Text of the Class Rules below:

I.10 MIXED-PLUS DIVISION

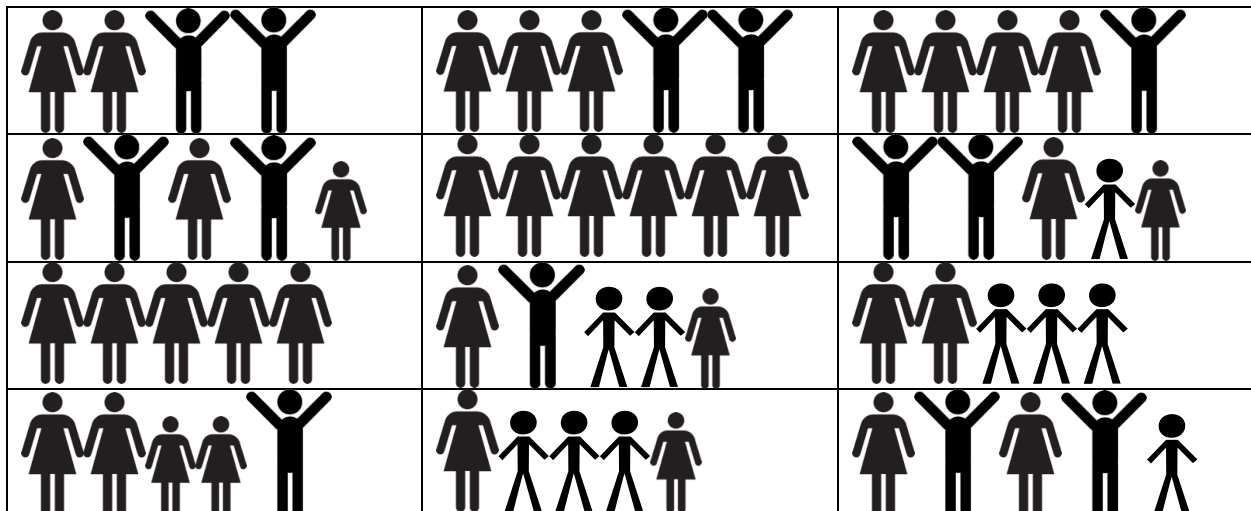
Regatta organizers will present awards for a Mixed-Plus division. To be considered as a Mixed-Plus team, Class Rule C.3 is modified so the crew shall consist of 4 or more persons and contain no more than two (2) males over 18 years of age. The Mixed Plus division shall be scored as a sub-division of the whole fleet using the competitor's actual scores.

I.11 MIXED-PLUS EVENT

Class Rule C.3 is modified so the crew shall consist of 4 or more persons and contain no more than two (2) males over 18 years of age.

The original intent of Mixed-Plus events was to promote more participation for women in sailing. This is still the overall goal and emphasis of the Class, but the J/70 Mixed-Plus Class Rule was written to better allow families and young sailors to participate. In short, the only limit is no more than two men over the age of 18. This allows Class members to build whatever team configuration is best for them.
